**A WISBECH man has experienced success with a device he invented to prevent unauthorised access to rubbish bins.**

Steve Thompson received an enquiry from a local council asking how their wheelie bins could be secured and invented the BinSafe, a simple but clever locking frame.

The new product was officially launched at the recent Recycling and Waste Management Show at Birmingham's NEC and Steve received over 70 enquiries.
